## **Upcoming Site Days**

Every year volunteers help maintain the site & repair the amenities before & after the actual Festival weekend.

There is usually one site day a month on a weekend day between April & July, & September & November. There's all kinds of tasks - from piling fire wood, cutting trees, to building and repairing structures. All skill levels are welcome! Whether one day or all of them, the help is appreciated

Dates of site days will be given closer to spring. It would be great to have you join us up at that special place in the woods.

### Adult Music Camp - Learning, Jamming, Friendship

Blue Skies in the Community presents an immersive, educational, music experience.

We offer three 'streams' of workshops, each limited to about 20 participants and about 50 in total.

- "Bluegrass and Beyond" with Joey Wright is appropriate for folks who like to sing and play one or more traditional bluegrass instruments & want to explore traditional and modern bluegrass.
- "Singing Together!" with Evemarie Brunelle is for singers of all levels of experience and abilities to explore sound and rhythm, in unison and in harmony through learning songs from diverse cultures.
- "Singing around the Campfire" is under the guidance of Magoo. This is ideal for folks who
  know at least a few chords or tunes on an acoustic instrument and would like to play and sing
  with others in a casual, welcoming setting

Camp takes place at the Blue Skies Festival site. Participants may camp on site or commute. This year, camp runs Sun. July 28, 2024 (evening) - Wed. July 31, 2024 (noon). The cost is \$200 per person. Registration forms are available HERE.

# Calling all musicians, community groups and teachers! 2024 Community Grants are now available!

Each year BSIC supports a number of live music projects. In 2023 over 1,200 students from 9 rural schools experienced live music in the form of concerts and workshops including the opportunity to explore instruments from around the world. If you have an idea for a concert, workshop or anything in-between that will bring live music to your school, community group or event apply for a community grant - up to 50% of the cost of the project could be covered.

# Changes to the Mailing List

The Mailing List is a database of all of the folks who will receive a 2024 ticket request form/lottery card by email. Note - there is only ONE form sent per household. If who you live with or your contact info changes, tell us! Snail mail is available by special request.
